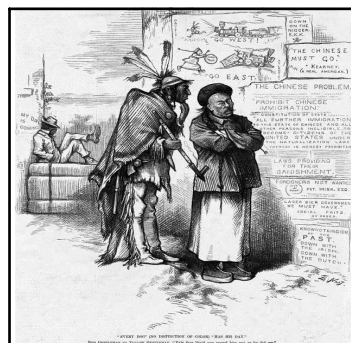
Analysis of Labor Movements and Impact

 The air-bridged harbor that twin cities frame.

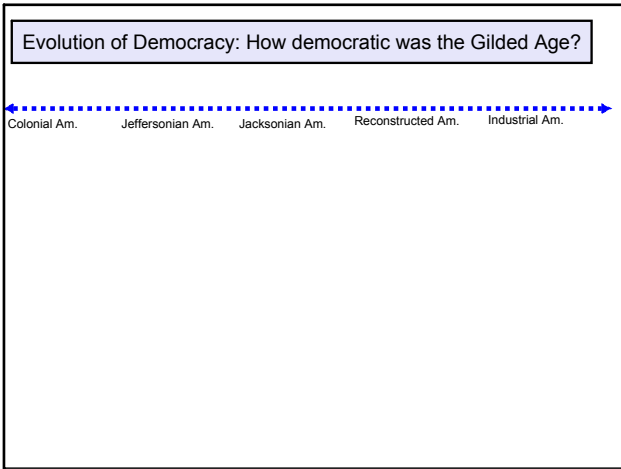
"Keep, ancient lands, your storied pomp!" cries she

 Emma Lazarus, *The New Colossus*



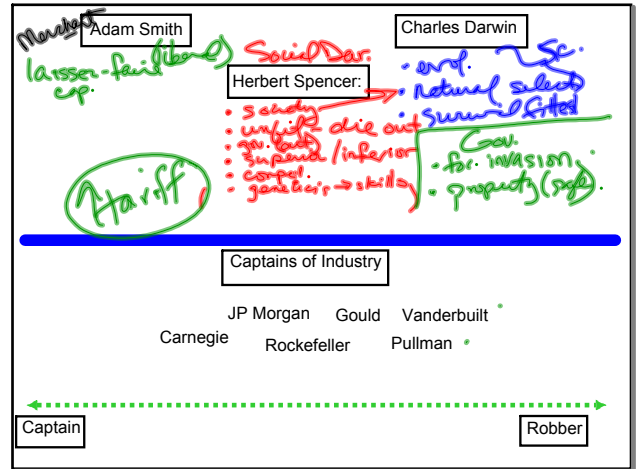

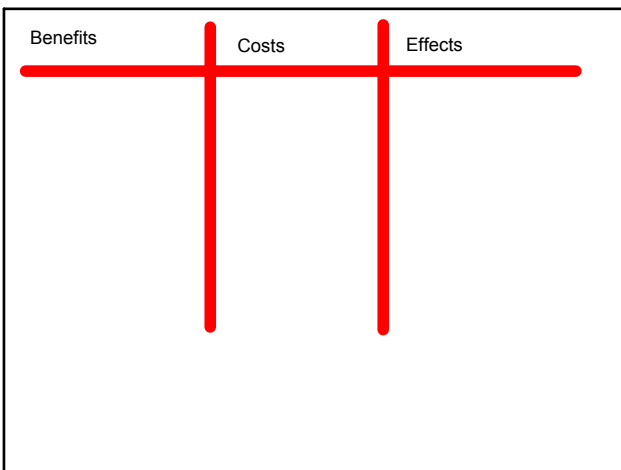

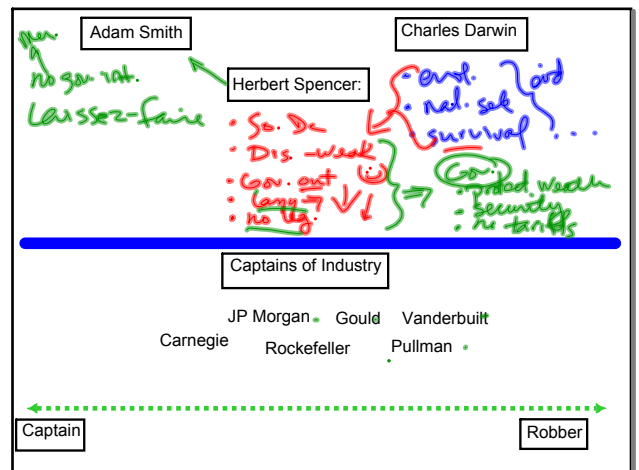
