


- Need to import manufactured goods

- Slavery
- Need for manual labor
- Ideal for farming
- Opposed to tariffs (taxes) on foreign imports
  Cotton, tobacco, rice, and indigo grown as cash crops


## Northern Climate



Veritical Thinking Question B: What is the most logical order for arranging these topics in the flow chart?


- Manufacturing prospered
- Shipbuilding, fishing, mining, lumber, furs "Yankee ingenuity" used to create ways other than agriculture to make money
  - Bad for farming much of the year
    - Population increased rapidly
- Favored tariffs (taxes) on foreign imports
  - Diverse (varied) economy
    - Need for skilled labor
- · Immigrants settled in North

## Southern Rivers



- Critical Thinking Question C: What is the most logical order for arranging these topics in the flow chart? Few large cities
- Immigrants not drawn to South
- Less power in the House of Representatives than the North
- Easy navigation and transportation
- Population smaller than in the North
- People lived scattered along rivers
- Agriculture-based economy
- Not much manufacturing

## Critical Thinking Question D: What is the most logical order for arranging these topics in the flow chart? Immigrants attracted to work opportunities

- People gathered in and near sea ports
- No need for slave labor
- Trade and manufacturing centers emerged
- Many cities developed
- Unnavigable
- Had more power in the House of Representatives than the South
- Large population
