A Bad Situation Made Worse

- The Dawes Plan: US loans Germany \$2.5 billion to pay back Britain & France from WW1
- Britain & France turn around & pay back us; thus, we pay ourselves back with our own money.
- Hawley Smoot tariff: Congress again raises taxes on foreign goods sold in US. World responds by raising taxes on American goods.
 World trade drops by 40%

Hoover tries to Help

 Establishes Federal Home Loan Bank Act, making it cheaper to own a home. Allows farmers/homeowners to keep property.
Establishes \$800 million public works program to stimulate business.

Not Enough

 Hoover believed in voluntary cooperation of businesses not to lay off workers.

 Did not believe in direct relief (giving money or food directly to the poor).

People get Angry

 In 1932, a group of WW1 vets/ families go to DC (Bonus Army)

Supporting Patman Bill: give WW1 vets \$500 bonus.

 Bill dies (Congress doesn't approve it)
Bonus army doesn't leave Hoover brings in troops, uses gas on the Bonus Army. Several

people (kids) die.

 Hoover's image suffers
Homeless camps pop up around country, called "Hoovervilles "
