# Levels of Questions

Level of question is  
determined by where  
the answer is found!



# Level I

- ◆ Answer is in the text; explicit, facts, who, what, where, when...
- ◆ Cinderella Story Example:
  - How many step sisters does Cinderella have?



## Level II

- ◆ Implicit in the text; inference; how and why; “read between the lines”
- ◆ Cinderella Story Example:
  - Why did Cinderella’s step-mother forbid her to attend the ball?





## Level III

- ◆ Beyond/outside the text; bring in outside knowledge; evaluate, judge; multiple answers; open-ended; not a simple answer.
- ◆ Cinderella Story Example:
  - What would have happened if Cinderella remained at the ball after the stroke of midnight?
