Context: Shifting meaning of terms "liberal" & "conservative."


- Classic Definitions: Liberal=change needed
 - Conservative=no change needed
- Industrial Rev.: Liberal=laissez-faire
 - Conservative=Mercantilism
- By second wave of IR:

Progressives jump start "Liberalism"--bigger role of government Conservatives want to keep laissez-faire/smaller role of government
