Marshall Court

- Established power of S.C. as final arbiter of Constitution & set precedent for judicial review (Marbury v Madison) (McClulloch v Maryland)
- Increased the power of national government at expense of state & local government esp. interstate commerce (Gibbons v Ogden)
- Pro-business stance given when rights of contracts upheld (Dartmouth College v Woodward)
- Accomplished this at a time when Federalists dominated only one branch of government
