Nixon

 1972 Watergate Scandal (members of CREEP break in to Democratic headquarters, steal documents, bug phones; Nixon eventually chaged with orchestrating a cover-up, story broken by Washington Post; quits before he is prosecuted)

- Pardons Nixon
- Inflation and economic recession (paying off Vietnam War)
- Fall of Saigon 1975
- OPEC oil embargo 1973

Carter

- Iranian hostage crisis
- Energy Crisis
- Three Mile Island Nuclear accident
- Soviet invasion of Afghanistan

- Strategic Arms Limitation Talks (SALT)
